Proposal for Yellow Lines and Bus Stops in Farm Road

You may recall Transport for London's consultation of 2019 on the proposed 456 bus route, connecting Enfield Town to North Middlesex Hospital via Firs Lane. The decision has since been made to proceed with the route.

Enfield Council supported the proposal, subject to suitable localised arrangements being found along TfL's proposed alignment, notably for the better service coverage it would offer those living in the Firs Lane area.

The plan on the reverse shows the changes the Council is now proposing to make to its highway network. Recognising some anxiety from the street about new bus stops and loss of parking space, we have sought a layout that retains sections of overspill domestic parking and that leaves the stopping position of buses away from fronting homes.
