Proposed Bus Stops on Firs Lane

Transport for London plans to introduce its new 456 bus route in February. Fixed bus stops will improve the accessibility of the service. <p>Bus Stop 24: Placing the boarding area on a build out near the junction minimises loss of parking space. Higher kerbs across 8m serves the front and middle doors of the bus.</p>	
<p>Bus Stop 25: Placing the boarding area on a build out, replacing the existing traffic calming island, minimises loss of parking space. Higher kerbs across 8m serves the front and middle doors of the bus, which straddles existing speed cushion when stopped at the intended position.</p>	
<p>Notes: > The bus stops will have higher kerbs, bus markings that keep the space clear of parked cars and a bus stop post. Bus shelters are not proposed. > Placing the stops near Hyde Park Avenue helps serve the catchment of homes east of the route.</p>
